

The Mediterranean Network of Basin Organisations was created in 2003 as a regional network of the International Network of Basin Organisations (INBO), to promote collaboration between all the basin organisations in the Mediterranean region.

 Project "MELIA": Mediterranean Dialogue on Integrated Water Management







- Objective: create an efficient regional management of water resources under scarcity conditions and to improve communication amongst Mediterranean countries.
- Started in September 2006









- MENBO's role: participation in 5 working groups
  - Assessment of Technological Perspectives in Water Management
  - Water Policy
  - Prevention and Mitigation of water conflicts
  - Building Knowledge
  - Recommendations on the application of the WFD (coleader of the group)
- Participation of representatives of practically the whole group of Mediterranean countries
