

# Managing and protecting water resources and their supply systems to meet human and environmental needs

- Basin Management and Trans -boundary water cooperation: institutional frameworks and benefit sharing
- Ensuring adequate water resources and storage infrastructure to meet rural, urban and energy needs
- Preserving natural ecosystems in catchments and coastal zones
- Managing and protecting surface, ground and rainwater








## 7-8 February 2008: 2nd Meeting of the Thematic and Regional Coordinators

- More than 400 representatives from approximately 200 organizations gathered for the Second Thematic and Coordinators' meeting in Istanbul on 7-8 February.
- The two-day meeting provided an opportunity for different stakeholders, organizations and institutions to work together and develop plans for the preparation of particular topics. Prior to the meeting, the participants had expressed their particular interest and split into 24 topic working groups within six thematic groups.

### Forum Political Process









- Involve decision-makers and trigger commitment
- Bridge the thematic process and the political process of the Forum;
- 3. Do not duplicate UN processes but design a process based on a dialogue and interactions between three political groups:
  - Governments
  - Parliamentarians
  - Local Authorities

- Involve representatives of the three groups
- Address themes from a political perspective in relation with the thematic framework
- Define and work on concrete objectives





Define, design and implement Forum processes: Dialogues, preparation of final documents/resolutions
