A Web portal is a single point of access to information which is linked from various internet based applications and of interest to various types of users.

<u>Advantages</u>

- Portals present information from different sources in a unified way.
- They provide an excellent way for organizations to provide a standard look.
- Access to the portal can be controlled and procedures are standardized.



EMWIS portal background



EMWIS portal is based on a multilingual web content management system (Naaya technology) based on glossaries and thesaurus for data indexing.

- Strong interoperability features (systems can exchange information)
- Allows non-technical people to administrate various aspects of the portal





Training Management in the Water Sector

The Improvement of Steering Competence in the Water Sector Project is considered as one of the four components of the Water Programme WP which is funded by the German Technical Cooperation GTZ.

The main goal of this project is to create an efficient demand-oriented training management system, which ensures and strengthens the capacity of the water sector organisations (MWI, WAJ, JVA) in fulfilling their tasks now and in the future.

The activities of the project will be coordinated and carried out by a HR-working group, where representatives of the HR-and Training Departments of MWI, WAJ, JVA and the GTZ/Consultant-team are working closely together. They will analyse the framework, conditions, methods and processes of how training in the water sector is managed (e.g. sector wide needs analysis, selection procedures of trainees and training providers, possible sources of financing etc.) and identify the room for essential improvements.

Furthermore they will develop long term training and career plans for the employees in the sector.

On the training providers' side they will cooperate intensively with all kind of organizations regardless if private or governmental owned so that in the end the relevant courses can be designed and adjusted to the training needs of the water sector.

Besides the close cooperation with the partner institutions it is agreed with InWEnt that they will support and contribute to the planned activities.

Moreover the component of the GTZ water program is part of a joint approach with JICA and USAID to realise a "Comprehensive Training Program for in the Jordanian Water Sector". The three organisations harmonised their preparations and co-ordinated their current and intended activities closely.
