Who are we?

Since the beginning of the extensive Euro-Mediterranean talks on water issues, the Ministry of Water and Irrigation was entrusted as Jordan's ambassador on water issues.

Integration of NFP Activities in the National Structures Related to Water

• The Ministry of Water and Irrigation (MoWI) is the official body responsible for the overall monitoring of the water sector, water planning & management, formulation of national water strategies and policies, R&D

Role also includes provision of centralized water related data, Standardization and Consolidation of Data

Integration of NFP Activities in the National Structures Related to Water

The Ministry of water and Irrigation embraces the two most important entities dealing with water:

- Water Authority of Jordan (WAJ): In charge of water & Sewerage Systems
- The Jordan Valley Authority (JVA) Responsible for the socio-economic development of the Jordan Rift Valley, including water development and distribution for irrigation

Integration of NFP Activities in the National Structures Related to Water

This relative position with respect to WAJ & JVA reinforces its leading role as a National Focal Point for the Euro-Mediterranean Information System on the know-how in the Water Sector.




Jordan's NFP Web Site

System functioning





Water Context





Jordan is an arid to semi-arid country with land area of 92000 sq km. Located to the east of the Jordan River. Jordan's topographic features are variable. A mountainous range runs from the north to the south of the country. To the east of the mountain ranges, ground slopes gently to form the eastern deserts, to the west ground slopes steeply towards the Jordan Rift valley. The Jordan Rift valley extends from lake Tiberias in the north, at ground elevation of -220 m, to the Red Sea at Aqaba. At 120 km south of lake Tiberias lies the Dead Sea with water level at approximately -405m. The southern Ghors and Wadi Araba, south of the Dead sea, form the southern part of the Rift Valley. To the south of Wadi Araba region lies a 25 km coastline which


