Aim

The "German-Arab Young Scientists Forum" is organized as an international information and cooperation initiative of the *Junge Akademie* and the *Young Academy* of the Arabic World. We invite to this meeting young scientists from different Arabic countries and Arabic scholars of the Alexander von Humboldt Foundation. The selection of the participants includes different academic areas, like natural and social science as well as the humanities, which should give the event an interdisciplinary character.

On the German side members of the *Junge Akademie* and selected members of other Berlin research institutions will participate.

The Forum should be an academic platform for exchange, where next to general information and discussion about relevant questions and problems of academia in Germany and the Arabic world perspectives for joint research projects should be discussed.

In addition it is planed to visit with our Arabic partners some of the academic research institutions in the Berlin area. Thus the aim of the forum is to internationalise the academic research in a lasting way.

The thematic focus of the forum will form questions about the situation and role of the natural and social science as well as the humanities in Germany and the Arabic World.


