







# Call for Participants: Online – Mediterranean Training to Mobilize Green Climate Fund (GCF) Support for Water, Energy, Food, and Ecosystems (WEFE) Projects

**Course Dates:** 1 October – 5 November 2025 (5 weeks) + additional week allocated for proposal submission.

**Format:** Fully online, modular learning with live streamed sessions, group assignments, and peer-to-peer exchange, final proposal submission for certification.

Organizers: Union for the Mediterranean (UFM) and Arab Water Council (AWC)

**Funded by:** Swedish International Development Cooperation Agency (SIDA) With the support of the Green Climate Fund

#### 1. Course Overview

The Mediterranean Training to Mobilize Green Climate Fund (GCF) Support for Water-Energy-Food-Ecosystems (WEFE) Projects has been designed to strengthen capacities across the region in developing high-quality, GCF-ready proposals. This 5-week online course combines expert-led webinars, interactive group exercises, and practical assignments to guide participants through the full project cycle, from concept to submission.

## **Learning Objectives:**

By the end of this course, you will be able to:









- Understand the fundamentals of the Green Climate Fund (GCF), including its goals, operational framework, and funding mechanisms.
- Identify and assess climate change-related challenges and opportunities for the Water, Energy, Food, and Ecosystems (WEFE) Nexus in the Mediterranean/UfM region.
- Demonstrate practical skills to design, develop, and submit project proposals for GCF financing.
- Foster multi-sector collaboration to support an integrated approach to project development and financing.
- Share best practices, successful case studies, and lessons learned to formulate GCF-eligible project proposals.

## 2. Participant Eligibility & Group Composition

To foster multi-sectoral collaboration, applications must be submitted in **national teams** of at least **2–3 participants per country**. Each team must include representatives from **at least two** of the WEFE sectors (Water, Energy, Food and Ecosystems). We encourage multi-country teams.

**Eligible Countries:** The Call is primarily open to all Mediterranean countries eligible for GCF financing, including:

#### North Africa:

- Algeria
- Egypt
- Libya
- Morocco
- Tunisia

#### **Eastern Mediterranean:**

- Lebanon
- Syria
- Palestine
- Jordan









#### Western Balkans:

- Albania
- Bosnia and Herzegovina
- Montenegro

#### Others:

Turkey

The call is also open to all GCF-eligible countries worldwide interested in Mediterranean WEFE nexus approaches.

## **Country Team Profile Requirements:**

- Mid-career professionals
- Minimum 5 years of experience in at least two WEFE sectors
- Demonstrated track record in project development, proposal writing, or project management
- English fluency (written and spoken) is required
- Availability to participate in scheduled live sessions and complete assignments over the full 5-week period

## 3. Application Process

- Who can apply: Application is open for all eligible country representatives from Ministries, GCF accredited institutions, Private sector, NGOs, research institutions, and other relevant organizations fulfilling the application criteria.
- 2. Applicants from <u>GCF National Designated Authorities (NDA)</u> are particularly encouraged to form a team (2–3 members) representing at least two WEFE sectors.
- 3. **Application Package:** applicant teams must submit via the AWC online portal (URL):
  - Completed team application form (provided by AWC)
  - Individual CVs (max. 3 pages each)









- Statement of motivation (max. 500 words) explaining how participation will advance GCF readiness in home context
- 4. Deadline for Submissions: 10 September 2025 (23:59 CET)
- 5. Final Selection Announcement: 15 September 2025

#### 4. Selection Criteria

Applications will be assessed against the following weighted criteria:
