SUMMARY

This session will explore how Nature-Based Solutions (NBS) can be scaled up and mainstreamed at the river basin level to address growing challenges on water scarcity, ecosystem degradation, biodiversity loss, and climate change across the Euro-Mediterranean region. Building on existing European, Mediterranean, and national policy frameworks, the discussion will highlight practical experiences from river basins and identify the policy, financial, and technical mechanisms needed to support prioritisation of NBS in policies and related implementation. The session will also promote regional cooperation and knowledge exchange, strengthening the integration of ecosystem-based approaches into sustainable water, climate, and biodiversity strategies.

BACKGROUND & RATIONALE

The Euro-Mediterranean region is facing increasing water scarcity, climate change, ecosystem degradation, and growing pressure on water resources and biodiversity. Nature-Based Solutions (NBS) offer a no-regret approach to address these challenges while strengthening water resilience, restoring ecosystems, and delivering environmental, social, and economic benefits.

Although numerous NBS initiatives and pilot projects are being implemented across Mediterranean countries, their uptake and integration into policies and basin-level planning remain limited. Scaling up these solutions requires stronger cross-sectoral governance, cooperation between multiple stakeholders, technical know-how, evidence based decision making, and sustainable financing.

The session will provide a platform to share practical experiences, highlight successful approaches, and discuss the enabling conditions needed to move from pilot projects to basin-scale implementation. It will also contribute to strengthening regional cooperation and advancing the integration of NBS into water, climate, and ecosystem restoration agendas.
